



THE BENEFITS OF SaaS FOR MEDICAL PRACTICES



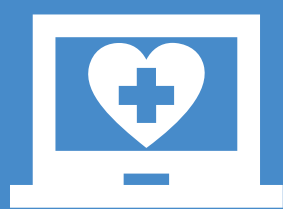
UPFRONT COST SAVINGS
